

Department 802 – Beef Cattle

Requirements:

1. Eligibility requirements for exhibitors in the open class beef show are outlined in the Oconto County General Rules and General Rules & Regulations For Open Class, Senior Citizens and Nursing Home Residents sections of the fair premium list.
2. Registered and grade animals will be shown together in breed classes.
3. All health requirements must be met before the animals are entered. See Health Requirements Section of the fair premium list.
4. Open class beef entries will be accepted Friday afternoon after the completion of the junior beef show. All open class beef cattle entries must be checked in with the superintendent by 1:00 PM on Friday.
5. Open class beef cattle must be removed from the grounds following the open class beef show.
6. Tardy exhibitors in any beef class will be called to the ring two (2) times, after which judging of the class will begin without the tardy exhibitors.
7. For class definitions, see Chapter ATCP 160.08 and 160.09 sections of the fair premium list.
8. The Oconto County open beef show is a ribbon only event--no premiums will be paid.
9. The Open Class beef cattle show will be Friday, of the Fair, beginning at 3:00 pm.
10. Animals exhibited in the Junior Fair Show cannot be shown in Open Class.

CLASS A-BEEF BREEDING CATTLE, ANY BREED OR CROSSBRED

Lot Number

1. Heifer calf, Junior - January 1, 2006 to April 15, 2006
2. Heifer calf, Senior - September 1, 2005 to December 31, 2005
3. Heifer, Summer Yearling - May 1, 2005 to August 31, 2005
4. Heifer, Junior Yearling - January 1, 2005 to April 30, 2005
5. Heifer, Senior Yearling - September 1, 2004 to December 31, 2004
6. Cow, 2 yrs. & over - Born before September, 2004

CLASS B - BEEF MARKET CATTLE

Lot Number

1. Steer, senior calf, born Sept. 1, 2005 to Dec. 31, 2005
 2. Steer, summer yearling, born May 1, 2005 to Aug. 31, 2005
 3. Steer, junior yearling, born Jan. 1, 2005 to April 30, 2005
 4. Steer, dairy-both parents dairy breeds
 5. Steer, dairy-beef crossbred-one dairy and one beef breed parents
- NOTE: Steers must be under 2 years of age at fair time as determined by mousing. Steers should be born after January 1 of year preceding this year's fair.
